

How the Appeal Works

We're sending out a 'slimmed down' version of our Appeal pack this year as face to face events are uncertain and we are focussing on making sure we use as much resource as possible in our frontline services.

1. APPEAL ENVELOPES

Enclosed in this package are a number of yellow gift envelopes for distribution to your congregation/group. A poster is available online if you prefer to leave the envelopes accessible during opening your building for individual prayer.

We know things are different this year, if you are unable to use our appeal envelopes it would be greatly appreciated if you could return them to us in order that we might re-distribute them.

2. GIFT AID

We are able to reclaim tax from the government by the use of the Gift Aid scheme. The envelopes have the form printed on them and if they are completed we would be grateful if you would make sure that they have all the details on them and return the completed envelopes to us for our tax claim records. We enclose a pre-addressed envelope for this purpose.

3. HOW TO GET YOUR MONEY TO US

Any money collected on behalf of St Petrocs can be banked direct to any branch of Lloyds Bank, using the enclosed paying-in slip.

Please note that each paying-in slip has a reference number identical to the one on your letter and specific to your organisation.
